Registration of Livestock and Poultry Premises

Section 1. Applicant Information	Complete and sign Section 1. The applicant may be contacted by the BC Ministry of Agriculture during initial verification and annually for information maintenance. If an applicant is simply updating Applicant Information, it is not necessary to complete Section 2
Section 2. Premises Information <i>Part A. Primary Premises</i> <i>Part B. Linked Premises</i>	Complete a copy of Section 2 for each separate livestock or poultry operation you manage. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register at least one location as a primary livestock or poultry premises for this operation. • Register all additional locations that are linked with the primary premises identified in Part A.

DEFINITIONS:

- Location -** A location is a physical parcel of land in British Columbia defined by a legal land description or by geo coordinates.
- Primary Premises -** Each separate livestock AND/OR poultry operation requires at least one location to be registered as a primary premises. A primary premises is usually where the main ranch or main barn is located.
- Linked Premises -** Additional locations, such as summer pasture or a secondary barn, can be registered as linked with the primary premise if they
- are managed with the primary premises as one farm or ranch and;
 - have livestock frequently moving between premises and;
 - are not associated with any other operation and;
 - are located within British Columbia.
- Additional locations which do not meet these criteria must be registered as primary premises.

The primary premises in combination with all linked premises may be considered as a “single epidemiological unit” or “single bio-security zone” for emergency response purposes because of the regular movement of animals between them.

EXAMPLES:

1. If you raise broiler chickens at multiple locations but never move or commingle birds between those locations, complete a **Section 2. Part A. Primary Premises** for each location.
2. If you operate a commingling operation such as a custom heifer raising facility, exhibition, fair, processing facility or auction barn, complete a **Section 2. Part A. Primary Premises** for each location.
3. If you operate a dairy farm that includes a milking location and one or more additional locations used for pasture or on farm heifer growing, complete a **Section 2. Part A. Primary Premises** for the milking location and a **Section 2. Part B. Linked Premises** for each pasture and heifer location. See example 2 if you operate a custom heifer raising facility.
4. If you operate a beef cattle ranch that includes a main ranch site and one or more additional locations that accommodate animals only from your ranch (i.e. not community pasture or shared crown range), complete a **Section 2. Part A. Primary Premises** for the main ranch and a **Section 2. Part B. Linked Premises** for each additional location.
5. If you operate a hog farm with farrowing and weaning barns at one location and grower-finishing barns at a separate location, complete a **Section 2. Part A. Primary Premises** for one of the locations and a **Section 2. Part B. Linked Premises** for each additional location.
6. If you operate a farm that has a main business office which does not accommodate animals and one or more additional locations which accommodate animals, complete a **Section 2. Part A. Primary Premises** for the primary location stating no animals present and a **Section 2. Part B. Linked Premises** for each additional location accommodating animals.
7. If you had previously registered a premises and your contact information has since changed, complete **Section 1. Applicant Information**.
8. If you had previously registered a premises but emergency contact information, premises type or animal type has changed, complete **Section 1. Applicant Information and Section 2. Premises Information**.
9. If you had previously obtained a premise identification number from the Canadian Cattle Identification Agency (CCIA), complete a full application to register the premise identification number with BCPID.

Section 1 must be accompanied by AT LEAST ONE completed **Section 2. Premises Information**. However, if an applicant is simply updating Applicant Information, it is not necessary to complete Section 2.

SECTION 1. APPLICANT INFORMATION

The applicant may be contacted by the BC Ministry of Agriculture during initial premises verification or for subsequent maintenance verification. The applicant will receive an aerial photo map detailing each location included with this application.
