

# How to Apply!

Dear Grain Producer:

Thank you for your interest and welcome to the Production Insurance Program (formerly known as Crop Insurance). For general information on the grain program refer to the grain brochure. For detailed information, please refer to the grain policy wording which defines the terms of your insurance contract with each party's rights and responsibilities. Below is a list of all the necessary Schedules to be completed to insure your grain crops. The rest of the letter explains the application process in more detail.

| 2) Schedule L-1 | - | Land Inventory<br>(if the land is leased or rented, a legal lease agreement must be submitted with your application) |
| 3) Schedule L-2 | - | Farm Map(s)  |
| 4) Schedule F-6 | - | Grain & Oilseed Field Inventory and Seeded Crop Report   |
| 5) Schedule W-1 | - | Warranties   |

Your Production Insurance coverage will be based on the information you provide in the above Schedules.

Once you have completed the schedules, mail them to your local Production Insurance office. We will review the information and write your offer. If you prefer, please call us and make an appointment for assistance in filling out the schedules.

After we have written your offer, you will receive a Statement of Premiums and Coverage (SPC), and an Options Report which details your available coverage, options and premiums. Please let us know if you require any assistance in choosing which coverage, options and premiums are right for you.

Once you have chosen which coverage, options and premiums are right for you, please sign your Statement of Premiums and Coverage (SPC) and an Options Report. Send them to our office along with your cheque. Make your cheque payable to the **Minister of Finance**.
